





ENDING YOUR FIVE YEARS? HERE ARE YOUR OPTIONS

2010 marks the end of a five year commitment to the Carpenter's Kids Program for some of our New York parishes. We are proud to say, that we have already received positive feedback from several that they wish to continue.

Here are the options when you reach your five years:

- Continue to support your original number of Carpenter's Kids for another five years. Funds will follow the children into secondary school or vocational training.
- 2. End your involvement in the Carpenter's Kids Program.
- Support only those children still in primary school. The commitment will be reevaluated each year to determine the number who remain in primary school.
