Vestry / Rector Leadership Grid The Episcopal Church of Our Saviour, Mill Valley, California

Vestry Leadership Overseeing the temporal affairs of the parish.

- Fiduciary Responsibility
 - Acts as "board of directors" for the "parish corporation" in accordance with church canons, parish by-laws, and appropriate civil law
 - Sets and oversees parish budgets
 - Maintains physical plant
 - Approves and signs legal and contractual obligations to which the parish is a party
 - Establishes and oversees standing funds
 - Maintains decision-making policies and procedures around all fiduciary matters
- Advisory Role to the Rector, representing the wider parish
 - Represents the interests and concerns of congregation in conversation with the Rector, other parish clergy, and the Diocese
 - Calls special and periodic parish meetings as it deems necessary
 - Seeks Diocesan counsel during transitions of the Rector or if conflicts with the Rector arise

Shared responsibilities:

- Build parish stewardship
- Develop staff contracts/agreements
- Evaluate staff effectiveness

Rector Leadership Overseeing the spiritual calls of the parish.

- Pastoral Leadership
 - pastoral needs and well-being of all members of the parish community are attended to
 - Presides and officiates over sacramental and pastoral actions of the parish in prayer, preaching, and worship according to church doctrine, discipline and the Bishop's pastoral directives
 - Empowers and equips the baptized leadership for ministry
 - Teaches out of the Christian tradition and Gospel
 - Engages in the collegial bodies of the wider church
- Administrative Oversight
 - Presides over the Vestry or delegates this responsibility (generally to the Sr. Warden)
 - Calls and supervises other parish clergy and staff
 - Ensures completion of canonical duties and responsibilities of the parish
 - Oversees day-to-day parish operations as bounded by vestry policies, budget, and diocesan and canonical guidelines

Shared Rector and Vestry Leadership Overseeing the parish's mission

- Articulating and leading the parish's mission in the Gospel of Jesus Christ
 - Develops and shepherds a long-term strategic plan for the parish, including concrete mission priorities
 - Builds and resources teams of members to help lead the parish in critical mission-based areas:
 - Evangelism visibility in the community, inviting others into the life of the parish, advertising, etc.
 - Gifts discernment exploring and articulating the gifts of the parish for ministry.
 - Needs discernment discovering the needs of the wider community and articulating how the parish's gifts meet those needs.
- Overseeing parish programs, mission work, and events
 - Vestry members and Rector both provide counsel, guidance, and support for parish programs and ministries and their leadership.
 - Regularly evaluating ministries and programs and discerns how they inform the call of the parish as a whole to mission and ministry.
 - Marshalling parish resources and stewardship to support and build up ministries and programs.
